**RE: Outstanding US Small-Cap Investment Performance Results
Van Berkom and Associates Inc.'s Registration with the SEC
Appointment of Dr. Lorne Switzer to the Van Berkom Chair in Small-Cap Equities
at the John-Molson School of Business at Concordia University in Montreal, Quebec**

I am pleased to report that the US Small-Cap Equity Management Division continues to demonstrate outstanding long-term investment performance results as indicated in the tables below and in the enclosed charts relative to our peers. Unfortunately, recent one-year results show underperformance. This is primarily due to the fact that our investment style (Growth at a reasonable price – GARP) is currently out of favor.

Since we now have three years investment performance results, we believe that we should begin marketing our US Small-Cap Division's expertise in the US market. As a result of this decision, we have recently successfully received our registration as Investment Advisors with the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") in the United States.

Finally, I am pleased to announce the appointment of Dr. Lorne Switzer to the Van Berkom Chair in Small-Cap Equities at the John-Molson School of Business at Concordia University in Montreal, Quebec. The purpose of the Chair is to teach, conduct and pursue research in small-cap stock investment and to establish programs at the graduate level concerning small-cap equities.

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Comparative Investment Performance Versus Russell/Mellon Universe of US Small-Cap Managers



VBA's US Mutual Fund Composite ranks 28th percentile and VBA's US Pension Fund Composite ranks 30th percentile in investment performance results of US small-cap equity managers for the three years ended September 30, 2003.

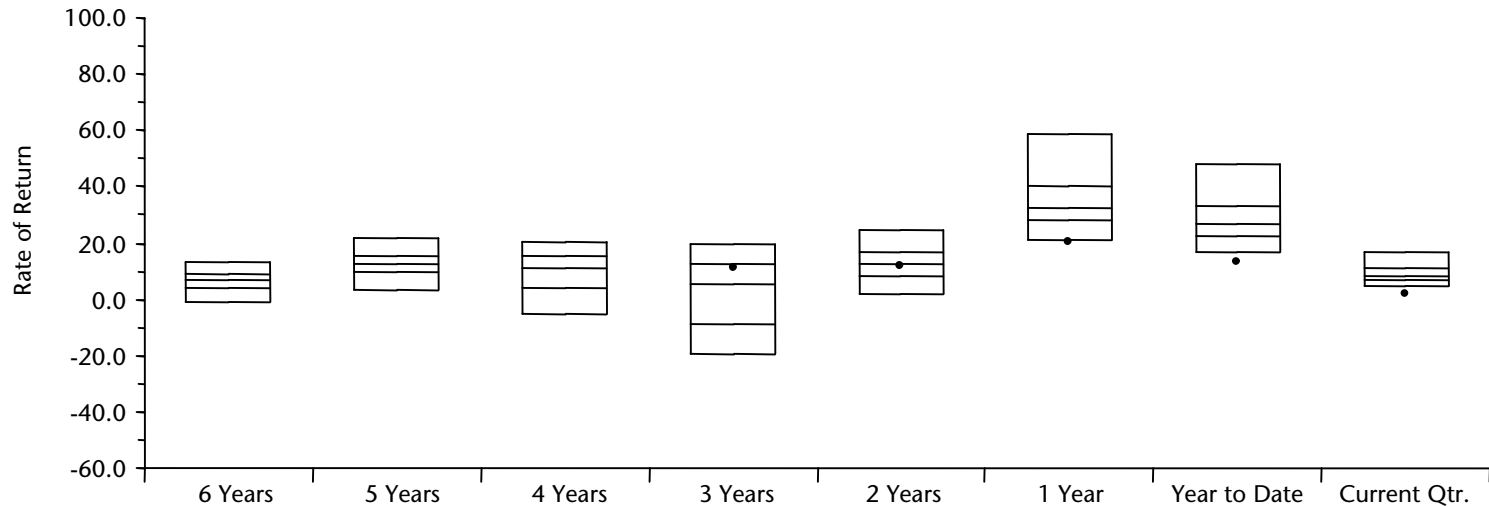

Total Fund: Rates of Return for Periods Ending September 30, 2003

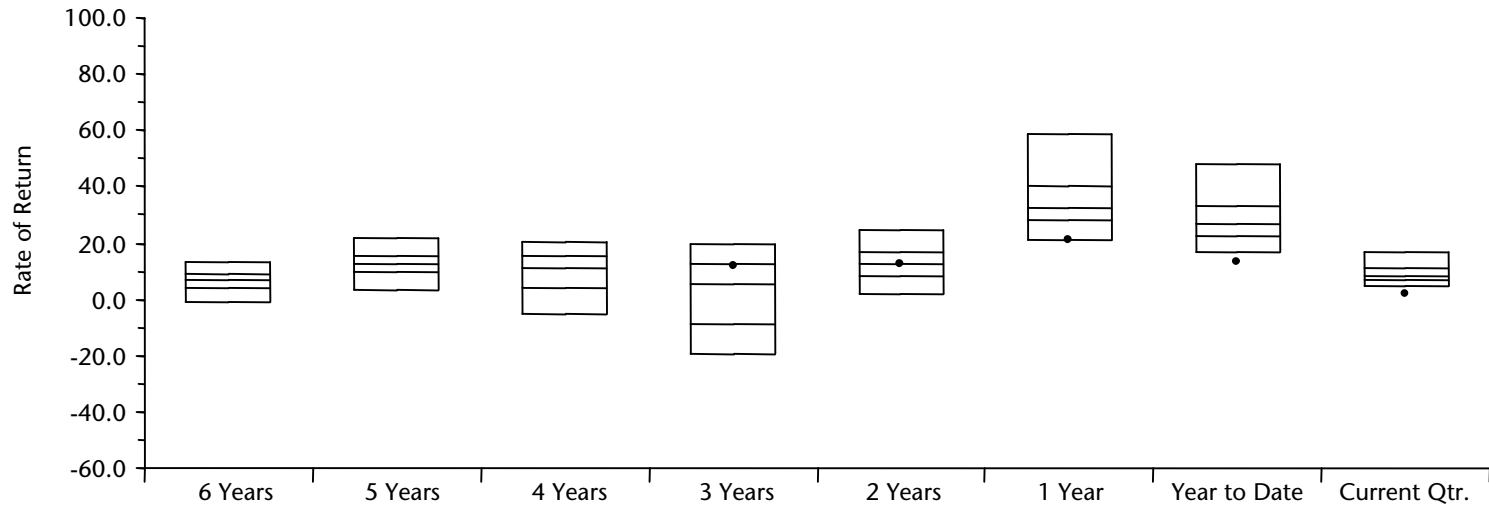

Total Fund: Rates of Return for Periods Ending September 30, 2003



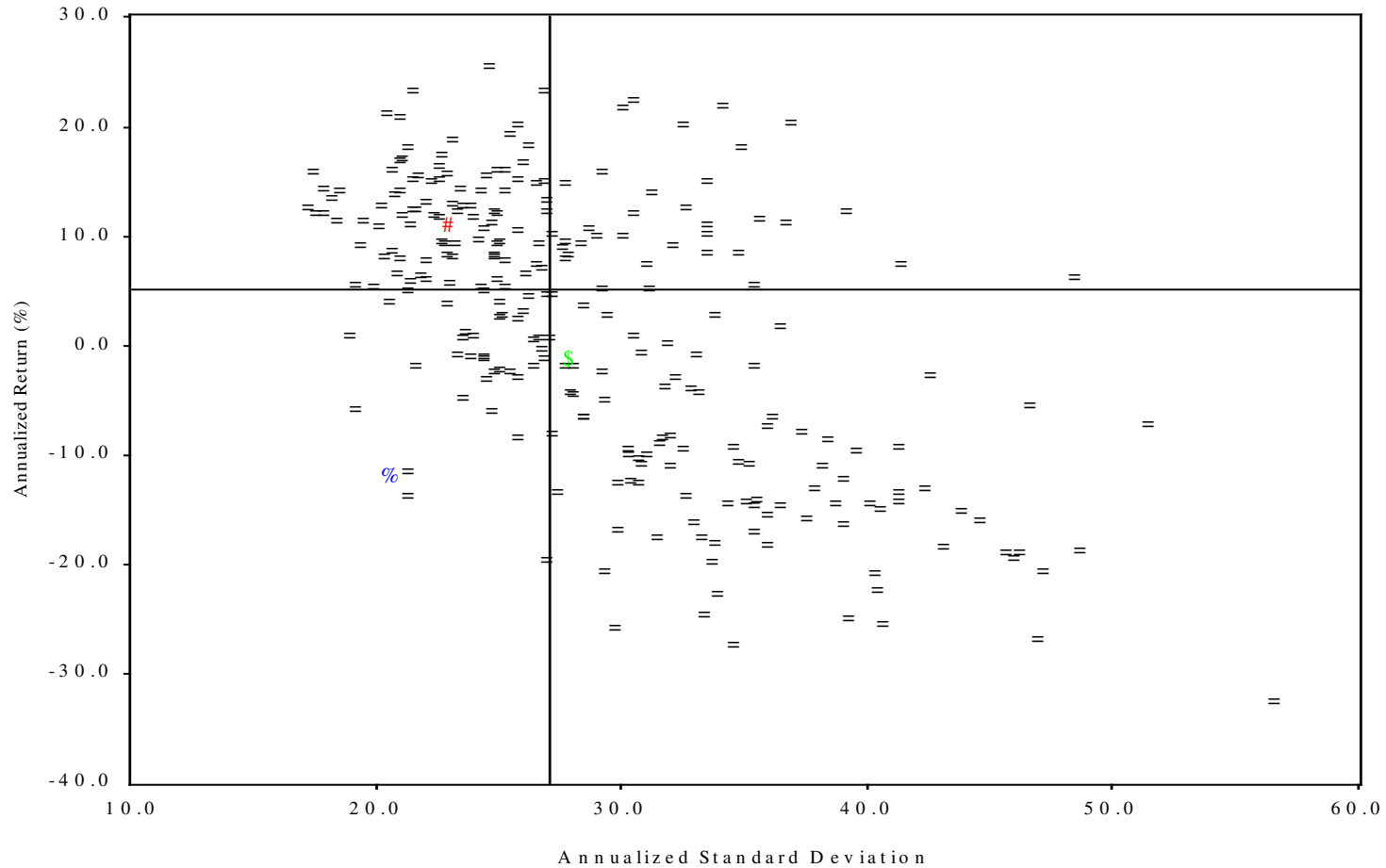

(Three Years Ending September 30, 2003)



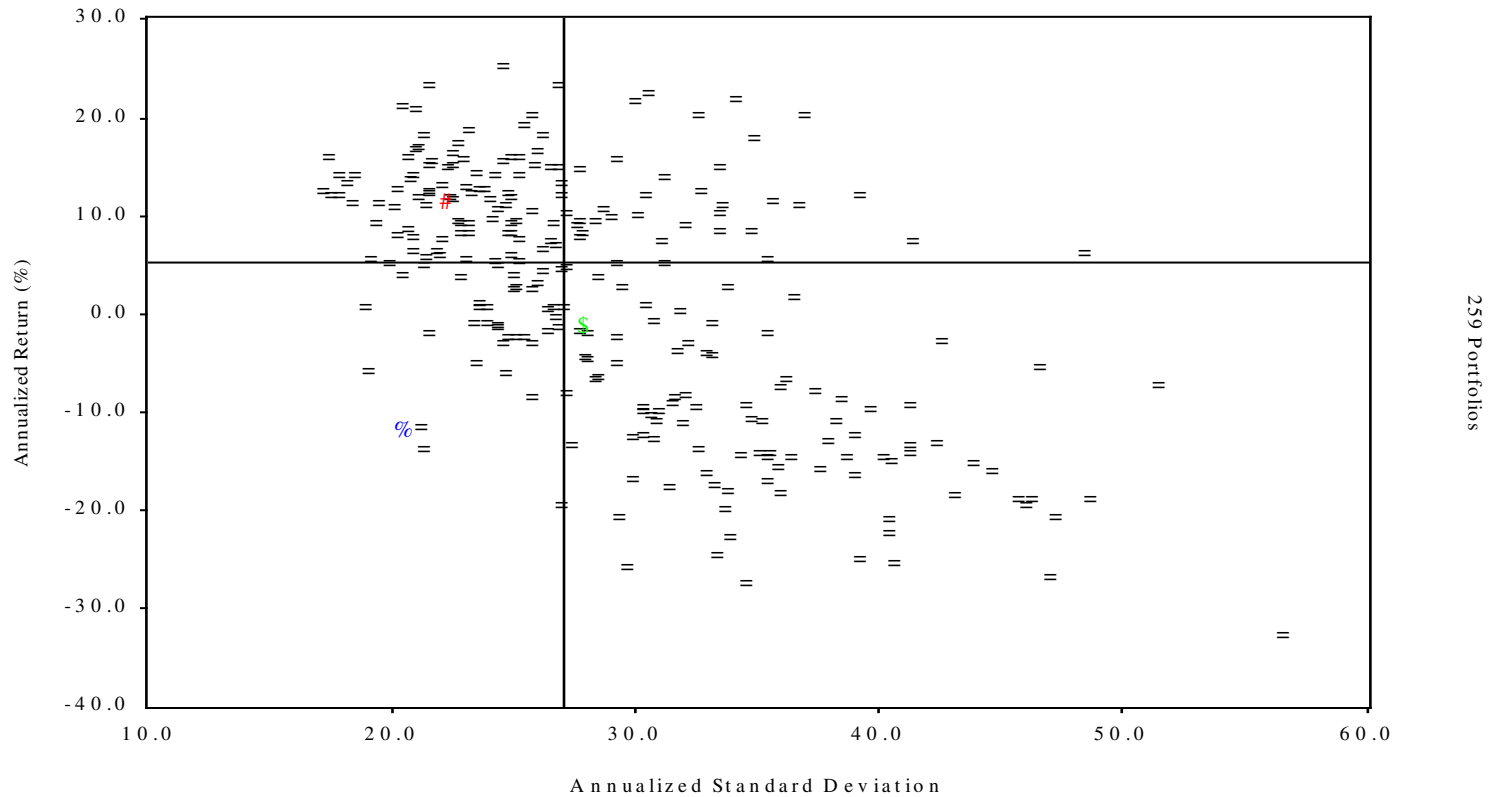
U.S. Mutual Fund \$ RUSSELL 2000 % S&P 500 PRICE
